ASHE North Central New Jersey Section is proud to invite Mr. Robert Matthews, PE, Past-President of our ASHE Section, Department Manager of the Highways Group at the Gannett Fleming who will be discussing the Route 18 Reconstruction project in New Brunswick, Middlesex County, New Jersey. This \$200 million multiple-stage project took several years to construct, and extends from just north of Route 1 and to the NJ TRANSIT/Amtrak Northeast Corridor rail bridge. Planning and design for this project involved many engineers, planners, environmental specialists, and members of the NJDOT and local community for more than a decade. The purpose of this project was to enhance the safety and operations of this section of Route 18. The reconstruction will improve corridor traffic operations by eliminating substandard roadway geometric features, managing access to and from the New Brunswick and enhancing access and mobility for pedestrians, bicyclists and transit users.
